



## Calmette & Yersin and Pasteur Network Postdoctoral Grants Call for Applications 2024

The Pasteur Network, comprising over 30 institutes, plays a crucial role in tackling global health challenges. Its distinctive strength lies in the diversity and extensive geographic reach, spanning 25 countries across 5 continents. This broad presence taps into a diverse scientific community, fostering a wealth of knowledge and expertise. Recognized as a WHO non-state actor, the Pasteur Network is frequently embedded into local Ministries of Health. It sustains a global infrastructure encompassing 50+ national and regional reference laboratories and 17 WHO Collaborating Centres.

To provide unique opportunities for talented young scientists to develop their project in one of this network's institutes, the Pasteur Network through Pasteur Network Postdoctoral Grants and the Institut Pasteur through the Calmette and Yersin Postdoctoral Grants launch together the 2024 postdoctoral grants with up to 2 new post doctoral positions.

The Calmette & Yersin program will support these **2 new postdoctoral positions** for the Pasteur Network. Applicants must propose an innovative research project within the scope of the scientific priorities of the host institute and/or of the Pasteur Network which are: vector-borne diseases, addressing the epidemiological transition and its consequences on ageing populations, maternal, newborn, and child health, and combating antimicrobial resistance via One Health approaches.

Applications must be written in English and submitted <u>online</u> no later than 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024. Incomplete or paper-based applications will not be considered.

Applications can be completed under the Pasteur Network Applications Portail.

Carefully review the grant guidelines provided for <u>Pasteur Network Postdoctoral Grants</u> before applying. Pay close attention to eligibility criteria, application deadlines, and any specific requirements or restrictions.
