In collaboration with their future thesis supervisor, candidates must propose an innovative research project on a collaborative program with an Institut Pasteur research unit, in line with Institut Pasteur's strategic plan.

Applications must be written in English or in French and submitted <u>online</u> no later than 1st of May 2025 (13:00 pm Paris Time). Incomplete or paper-based applications will not be considered.
